At the time of going to press the COVID 19 working party have put things into place for your safety and social distancing. If you have not confirmed your booking you may not be allowed in to attend Mass As lockdown restrictions begin to ease some things may change.

If you are awaiting results of a COVID test please wait until you have had confirmation of a Negative Test result before attending Mass.

To book a seat or family row for Sunday and Weekday Mass as **social distancing** has limited to 30 places within church or with families sitting together this may increase to 35. Please contact Linda John on 07535433890 by end of day on Monday.

The joint saying of The Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary and the Angelus before Mass has been suspended for the time being. You are asked to sit or stand at the appropriate parts during Mass **do not use the kneelers**. As a duty of care we are requested to give our name address and a contact telephone number for tracing purposes at all Masses. Facemasks or face coverings must be worn in church.

Holy Communion is by Host only and strictly in the hand with no exceptions.

If you can make your donations by standing order please request a form from the finance team. As income is way below expenditure at this time please consider if you could increase the amount given to the church as our outgoings have stayed the same.

First Confession and Holy Communion classes are expected to restart in July when and if it is safe to do so and the date will be advised to those concerned. First Communion Day is planned to be on Sunday September 19th at 11:30 am Mass. Will the Catechist team meet to decide when the classes will start and where they will be held as the hall is currently closed.
