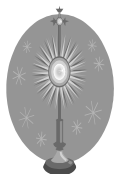

Peace to all! Below, please find Our Lady's August 2, 2019 message as give to Mirjana. "Dear children, great is the love of my Son. The Eucharist is the heart of faith. He has never left you. Even when you tried to go away from Him, He has not left you.
