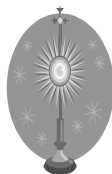

### Following the advice of the Catholic Bishops' conference of England and Wales they have agreed the following changes for COVID 19 restrictions:

It is important to reiterate that as Step 4 is reached, the general principles of continuing to create a safe environment in places of worship and their ancillary buildings are not abandoned. Indeed, the way forward must be a collective endeavour of all involved in the daily life of the Church in England and Wales. Recognition of the presence of the virus in the population means that certain preventative practices will still be required, and this is important to ensure that Diocesan trustees are seen to be discharging their Health and Safety duties.

### Facemasks or face coverings must be worn in church as a duty of care to to other parishioners

If you are awaiting results of a COVID test please wait until you have had confirmation of a Negative Test result before attending Mass.

You must use the hand sanitizer on entering church

There is no longer any need to book a place however you will still be required to sign in with your name and telephone number for track and trace purposes.

Please leave a space if sharing a row with other families

The joint saying of The Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary and the Angelus before Mass has been suspended for the time being.

You are asked to sit or stand at the appropriate parts during Mass **do not use the kneelers.**

Singing is allowed with masks being worn

Holy Communion is by Host only and strictly in the hand with no exceptions.
