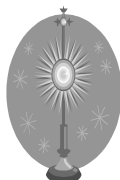

Following the advice of the Catholic Bishops' conference of England and Wales they have agreed the following changes for COVID 19 restrictions:

The Mandatory wearing of Facemasks or face coverings has been relaxed to a personal choice however, we still have a duty of care to all our parishioners when in church

If you are awaiting results of a COVID test please wait until you have had confirmation of a Negative Test result before attending Mass. You must use the hand sanitizer on entering church

We are still recording numbers of those attending Sunday Mass for the Diocese so give the numbers in your party to the Stewards.

You are asked to sit or stand at the appropriate parts during Mass **do not use the kneelers.** Singing is allowed.

The Sign of Peace has been reintroduced and you are now allowed to shake hands if you wish to. Holy Water is now available and is being stored in the cupboard marked Holy Water
