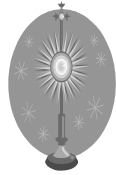

At the time of going to press the COVID 19 working party have put things into place for your safety and social distancing.

Please note we are in a Tier 3 restriction in Ashfield and stricter rules will have to be adhered to. If you have not confirmed your booking you may not be allowed in to attend Mass

If you are awaiting results of a COVID test please wait until you have had confirmation of a Negative Test before attending Mass

The car park will now be open with Social Distancing when walking from your vehicle into the church.

The joint saying of The Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary and the Angelus before Mass has been suspended for the time being.

You are asked to sit or stand at the appropriate parts during Mass **do not use the kneelers**

As a duty of care we are requested to give our name address and a contact telephone number for tracing purposes at all Masses.

Facemasks or face coverings must be worn in church.

Holy Communion is by Host only and strictly in the hand with no exceptions.

Christmas Eve 5pm Mass /Christmas Day 11:30 am Mass

You must book in for one of these masses as numbers are still restricted under the COVID rules. To book a seat or family row for these and Sunday Mass as social distancing has limited to 30 places within church or with families sitting together this may increase to 35. Please contact Linda John on 07535433890 by end of day on Monday. Booking is not required for weekday Mass as attendance is lower.

If you can make your donations by standing order please request a form from the finance team. As income is way below expenditure at this time please consider if you could increase the amount given to the church as our outgoings have stayed the same. We also have heating bills to consider as well.

Anyone with Red MISSIO boxes and FAITH IN FAMILY boxes are requested to bring them in for emptying and counting please leave them in the sacristy. Will the owner of the red box that has been brought in identify themselves as we don't know who to return it to?
