Following the advice of the Catholic Bishops' conference of England and Wales they have agreed the following changes for COVID 19 restrictions:

Please leave a space if sharing a row with other families You are asked to sit or stand at the appropriate parts during Mass do not use the kneelers. Singing is allowed.

The Sign of Peace has been reintroduced and you are now allowed to shake hands if you wish to.
